

ABOUT CAB


Campus Activities Board (CAB) is a student-led programming organization designed to provide a variety of educational, entertainment, recreational, and traditional programs for students.



Officer Scholarship


 CAB received \$11,000 for the Executive Board's officer scholarship

FY25 UTILIZATION


Officer Wages
