Income

Student Service Fees - \$604,437 (93.96%)

- o Salaries and Wages for Staff (Professional and Student Workers)
- o Fringe Benefits for Staff
- o Maintenance and Operations (Copier, Phones, etc.)
- o Student Career Services Programming

Central Designated Fund - \$6,000 (0.93%)

Funds from the university to pay for event space in order to host career fairs.

Other Designated Funds - \$300 (.05%)

o Funds received as part of the Cooperative Education Program (Co-op).

Sales and Services - \$500 (.08%)

 Funds come from programs and assessments that are not offered as a free service to various (alumni, faculty)

Programs/Events Income - \$12,000 (1.87%)

Gift Funds - \$20,000 (3.11%)
