



- Cost Breakdown
 - 3-year contract \$109,000
 - New Platform Implementation \$8,000
- Reviewing new opportunities to increase engagement and enhance student experience
 - Current Challenges: communication, customization, pathways, and app capability

Total Reduction in Base - \$32,665

- Student Wages

 - One major or multiple minor programs reduced
