Near-Miss & Equipment - Incident Report Form

A near-miss is a potential incident or hazard in which no one was injured, but where injury or further damage easily could have occurred with a shift in personal position or time. Near misses may be referred to as close calls, near accidents, or injury-free events.

UHCL asks that all employees report and correct near-misses and potential hazards concerns immediately to help prevent future incidents and maintain a safe work environment.
