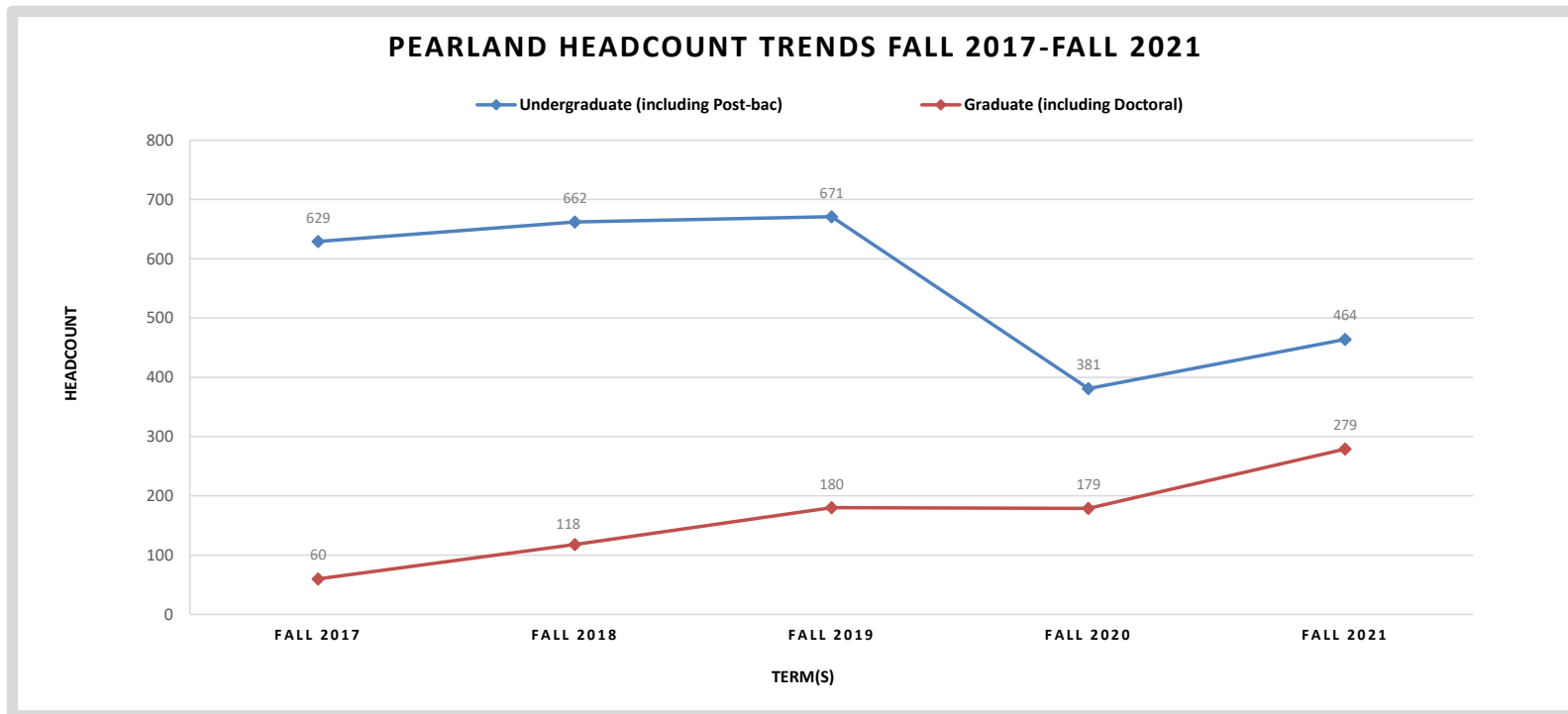

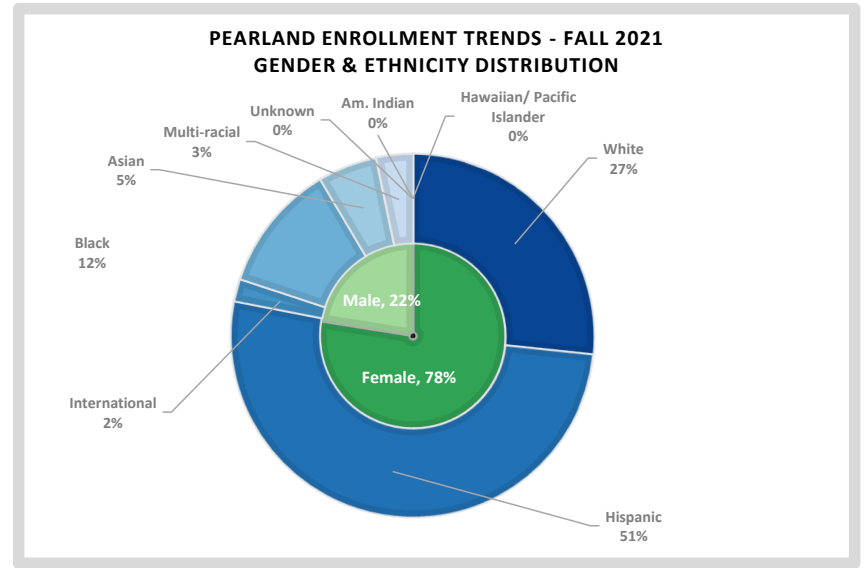
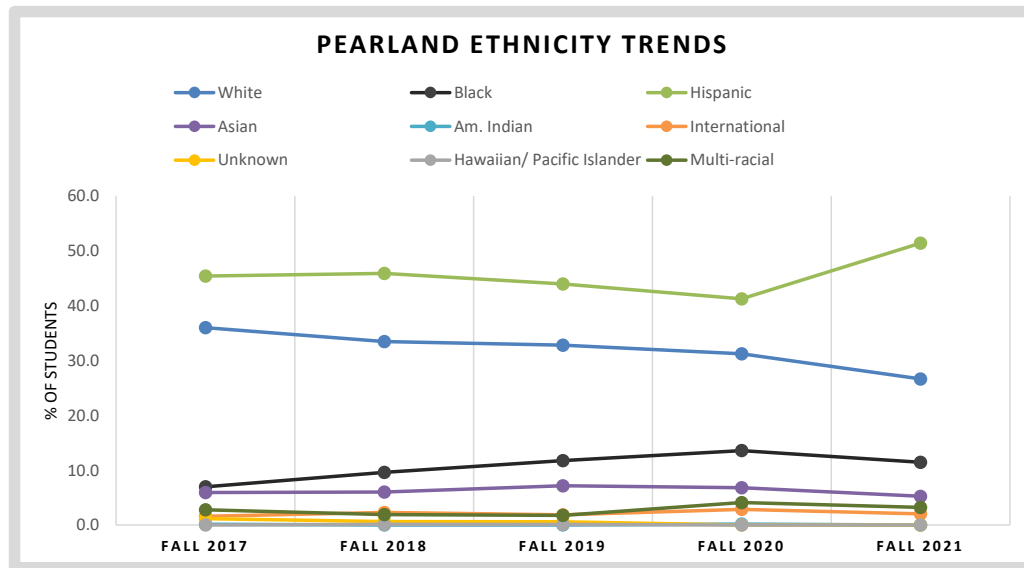

<sup>1</sup> Residency represents the county, state, or foreign country in which the student is a resident as identified by the student as his/her permanent address at the time of application to the institution. This variable should not be used to identify how students are actually charged tuition as other factors are involved in that determination.

<sup>2</sup> Tuition status indicates the status of the student for tuition purposes. Beginning Fall 2006 new measures were implemented to provide a greater level of accuracy for this variable. However, this variable is not a reliable indicator for how tuition may have actually been charged to students.
