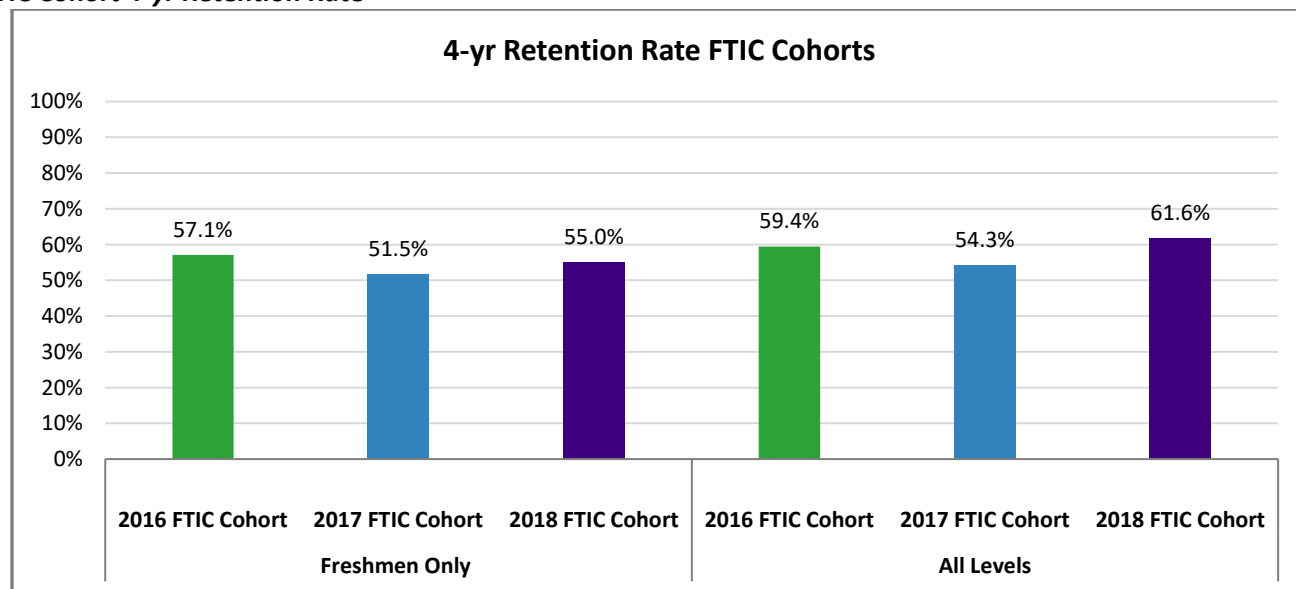

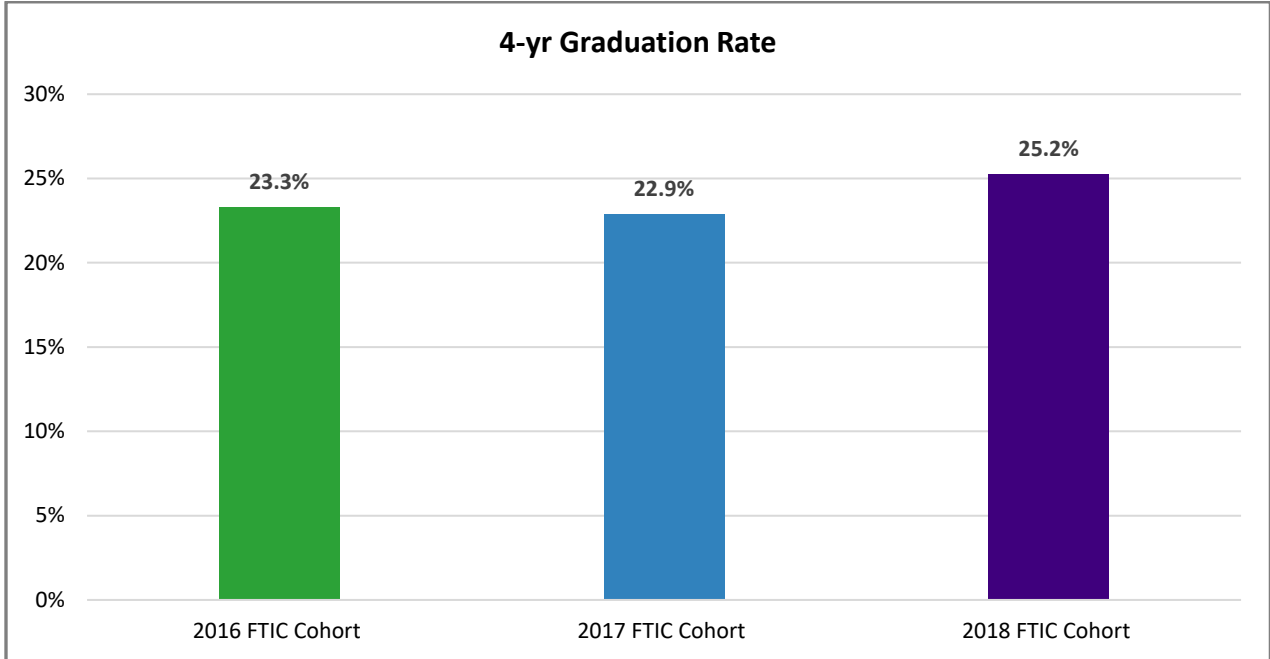

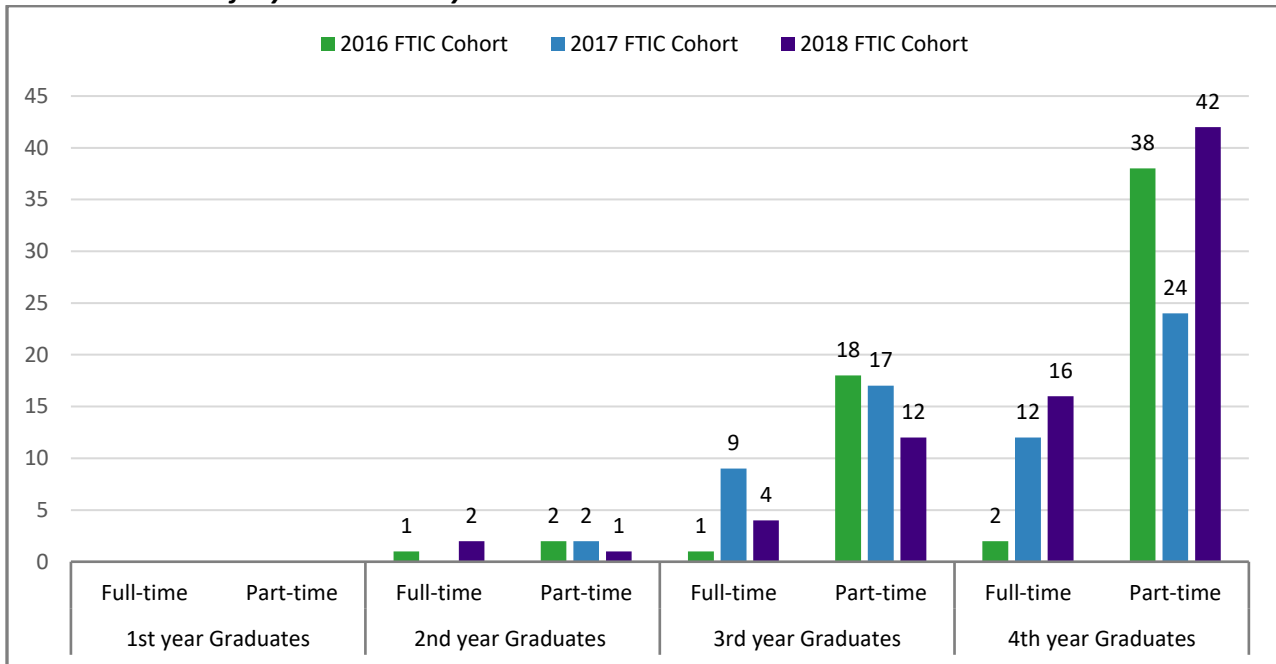
#### 2. FTIC Cohort 4-yr Retention Rate

**3. FTIC Cohort Number of 4-yr Graduates by Full-time and Part-time**



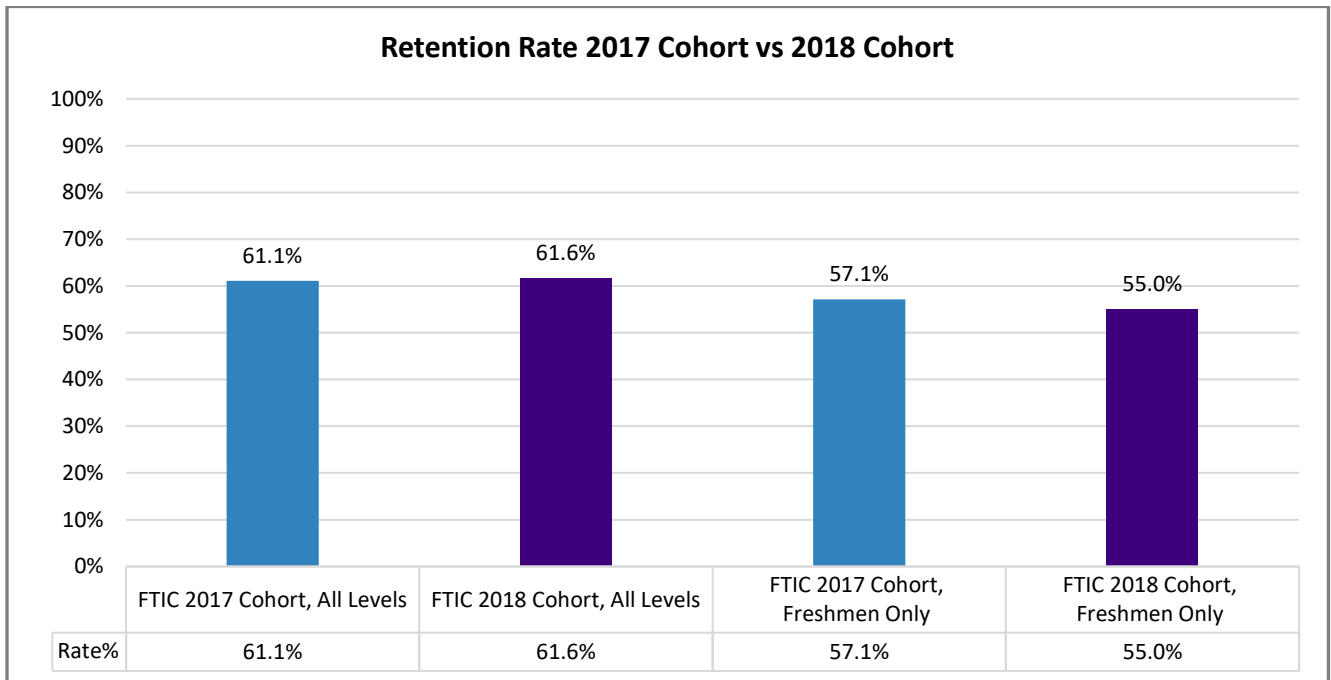

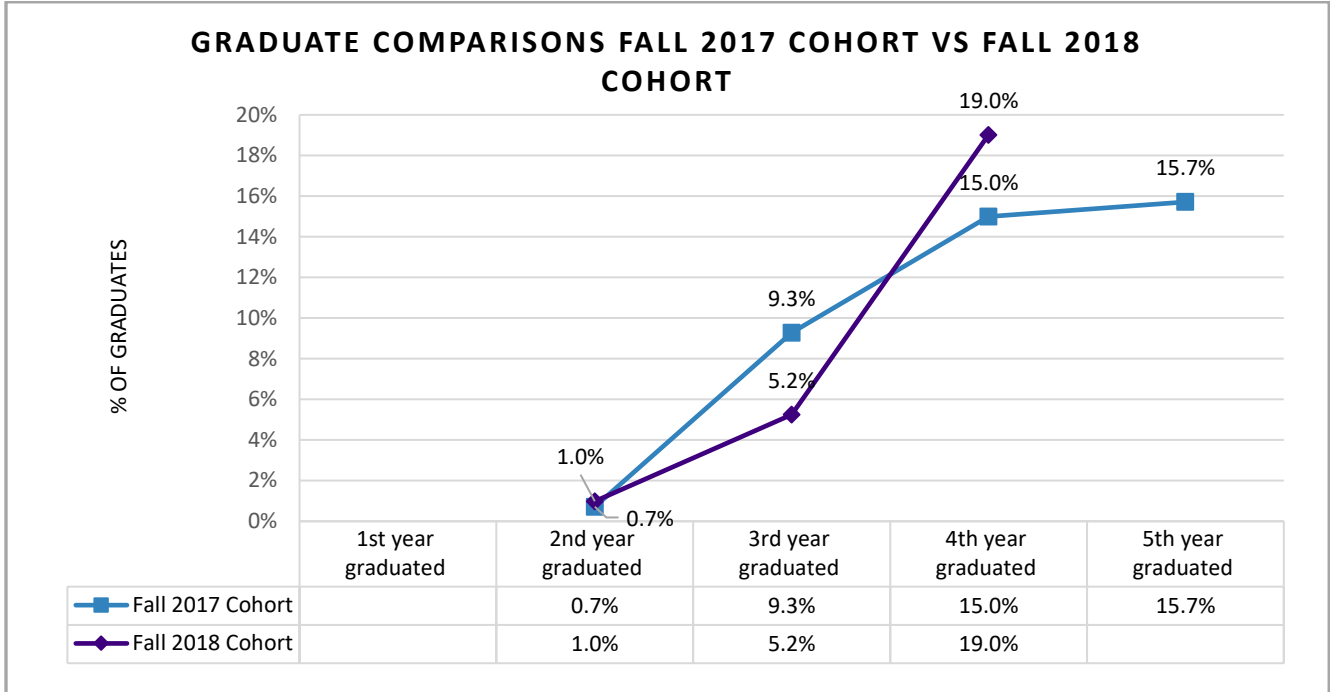

6. FTIC Cohort Retention Rate

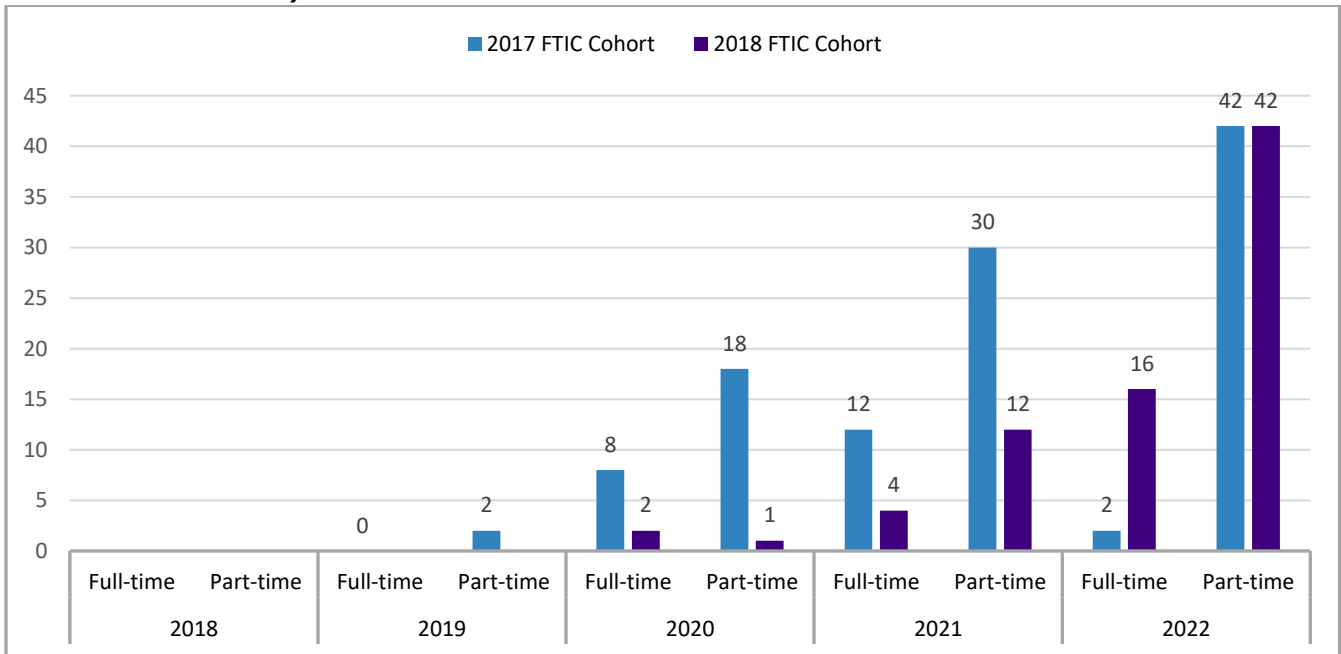


**7. FTIC Cohort Graduations Trend**

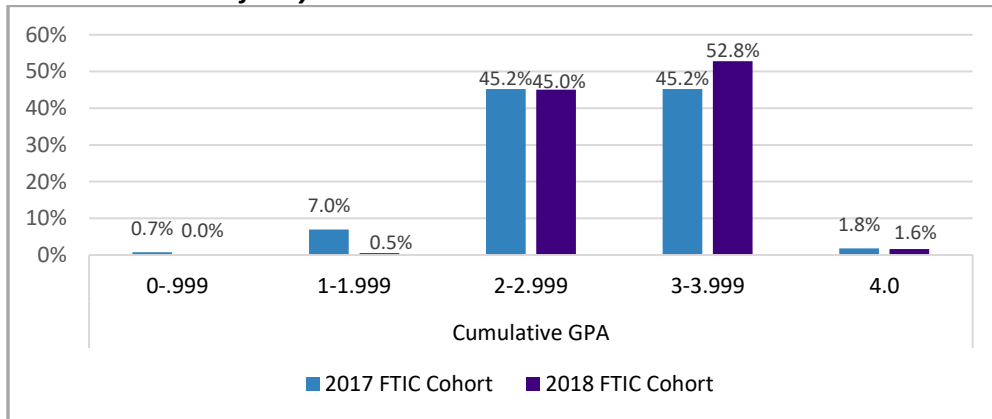

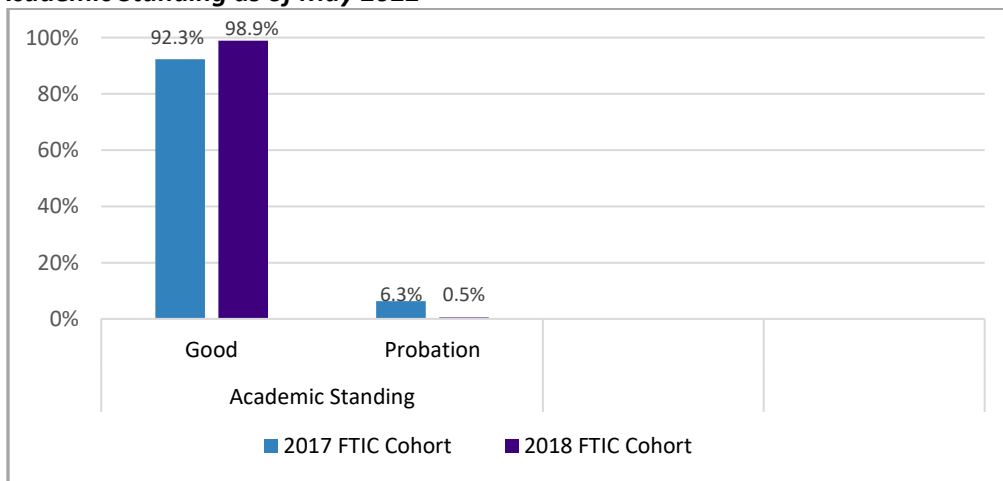

**20. FTIC Cohort Cumulative GPA as of May 2022**



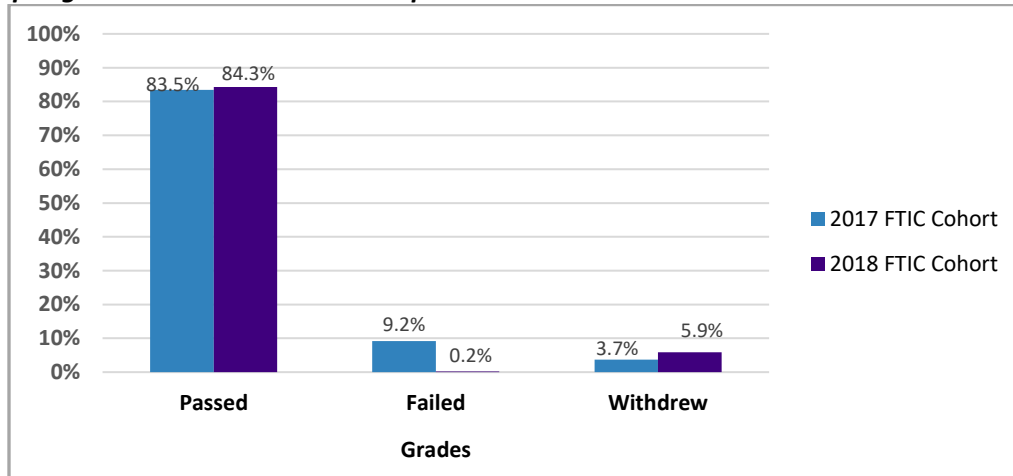
**21. FTIC Cohort Academic Standing as of May 2022**
