Graduating Student Survey College of Human Sciences and Humanities Fall 2023

Summary of the Survey

The purpose of the Graduating Student Survey is to determine the level of satisfaction of students with their recent higher education experience at the University of Houston-Clear Lake (UHCL). In addition, we solicit the students' opinions regarding which areas or issues need improvement to ensure that UHCL maintains the highest quality of instruction and support. Finally, the percentage of students who would recommend UHCL to family or friends is included in the UHCL progress card each year and is on the next page.

We conduct the Graduating Student Surveys in the fall and spring semesters using Qualtrics, a cloud-based software often used to capture a user's experience. The Office of Planning and Assessment sent an invitation on November 1st, 2023 to all students who applied for graduation during the Fall 2023 semester to complete the survey. The survey was active through December 10^{th,} 2023. You'll find the data grouped by college, degree level, gender, ethnicity, and program. The following pages summarize data collected in the Graduating Student Survey Fall 2023 by UHCL on the College of Human Sciences and Humanities.




What will be your degree level?


What is your primary degree program in the College of Human Sciences and Humanities?











If you were employed on-campus or off-campus, how many hours per week did you work?







To what extent is your employment related to your major or area of study at UHCL if employed, self-employed, or volunteering?





If employed, self-employed, or volunteering, how useful is what you learned at UHCL in your daily work at your place of employment?





If employed, how did you find your position?





If you're continuing as a full-time or part-time student, what is the highest degree you plan to earn?





Were you primarily a full-time or part-time student while at UHCL?





Did you start your undergraduate education at UHCL, or did you transfer from another institution?




