

Graduating Student Survey Fall 2023

By the Office of Planning & Assessment

University of Houston-Clear Lake

Summary of the Survey

The purpose of the Graduating Student Survey is to determine the level of satisfaction of students with their recent higher education experience at the University of Houston-Clear Lake (UHCL). In addition, we solicit the students' opinions regarding which areas or issues need improvement to ensure that UHCL maintains the highest quality of instruction and support. Finally, the percentage of students who would recommend UHCL to family or friends is included in the UHCL progress card each year and is on the next page.

We conduct the Graduating Student Surveys in the fall and spring semesters using Qualtrics, a cloud-based software often used to capture a user's experience. The Office of Planning and Assessment sent an invitation to all students who applied for graduation during the Fall 2023 semester to complete the survey on November 1st. The survey was active through December 10th, 2023. You'll find the data grouped by college, degree level, gender, ethnicity, and program. The following pages summarize data collected in the Graduating Student Survey Fall 2023 by UHCL as a whole and the individual colleges.

Quick points for UHCL

Demographics

Respondents:

A total of 999 UHCL graduating students were invited to participate. During this collection period, 512 students started the survey. If students exited the survey session before completing it, they had 72 hours to return and complete the survey, and 80 students did not complete the survey. However, their responses are included in the results. The median completion time of those who finished was 5 minutes and 20 seconds. The response rate for this survey is 51.25%.

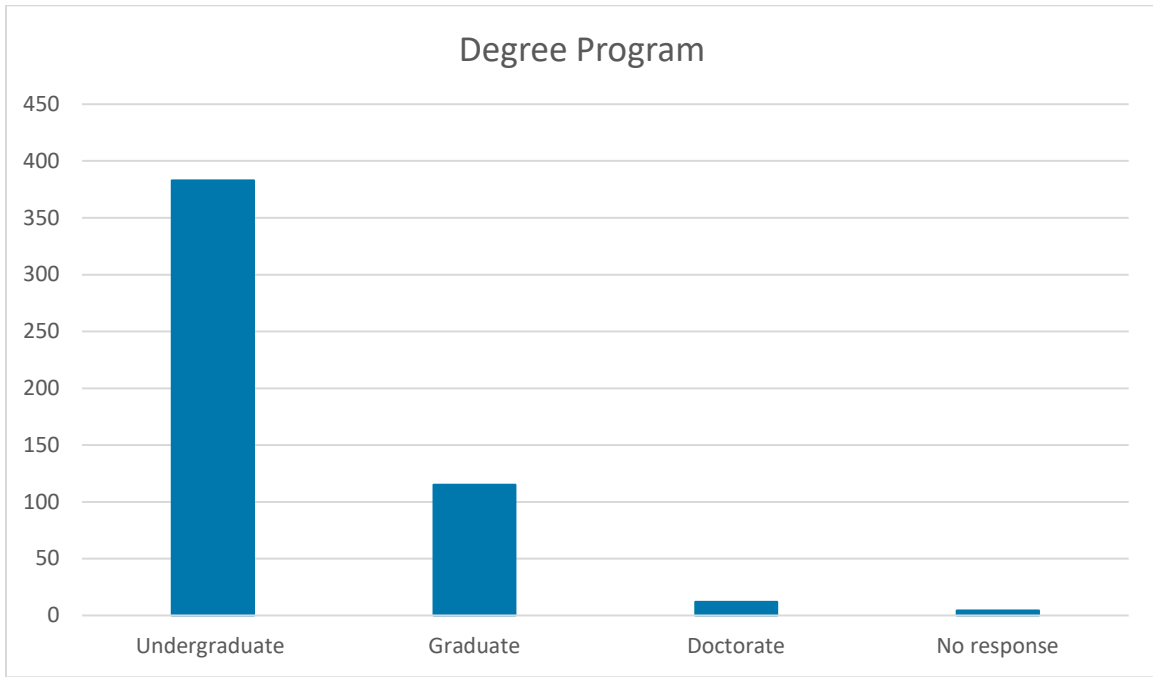

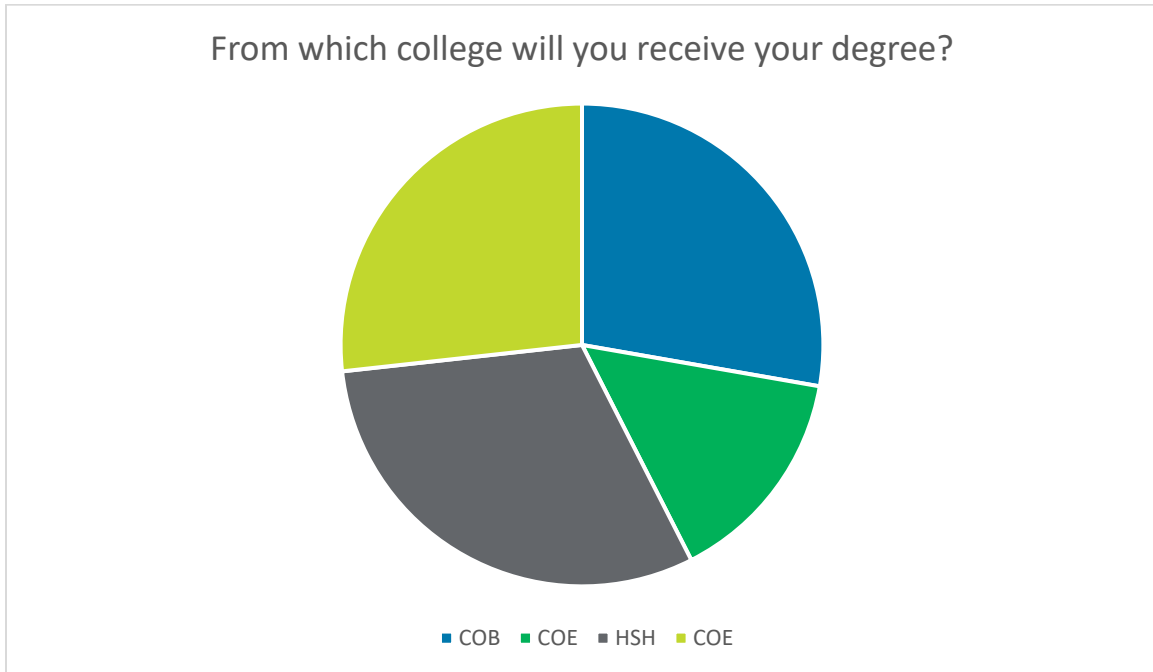

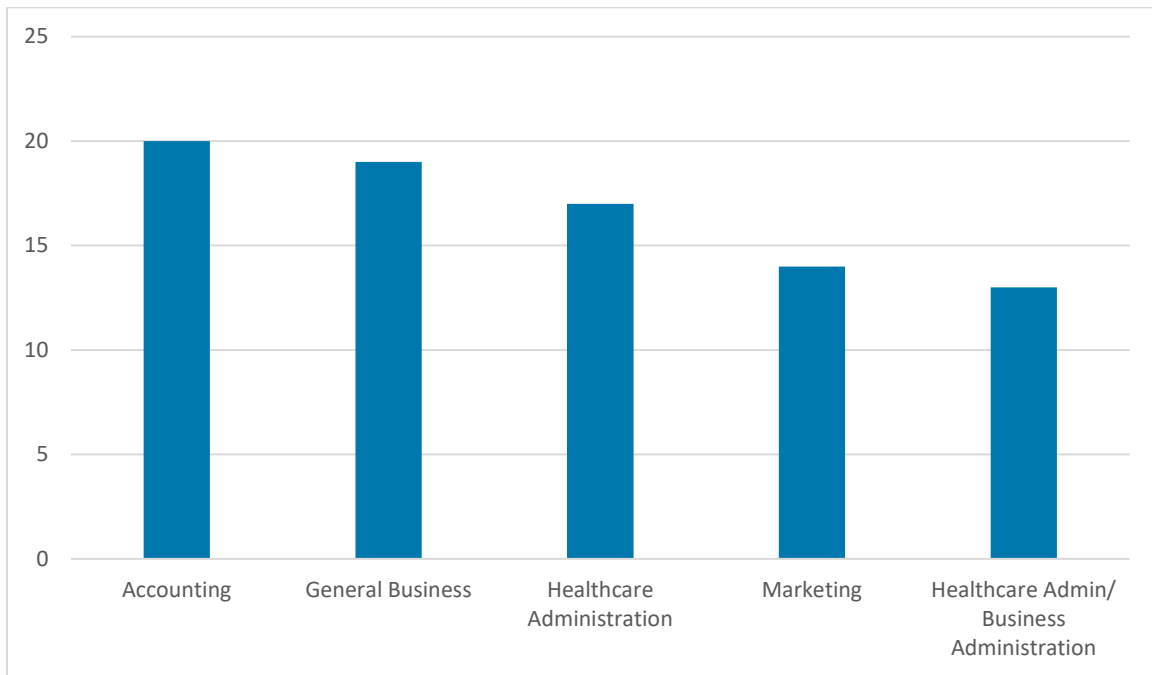
From what college will you receive your degree?

What is your primary degree program in the College of Business?

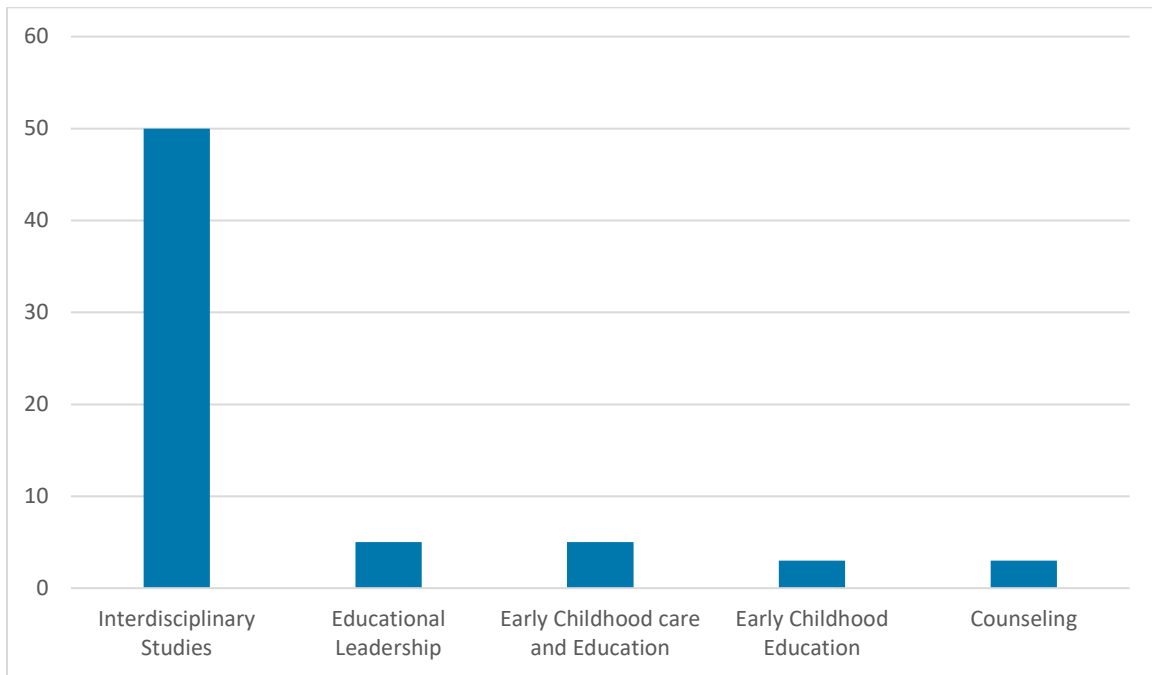

What is your primary degree program in the College of Education?

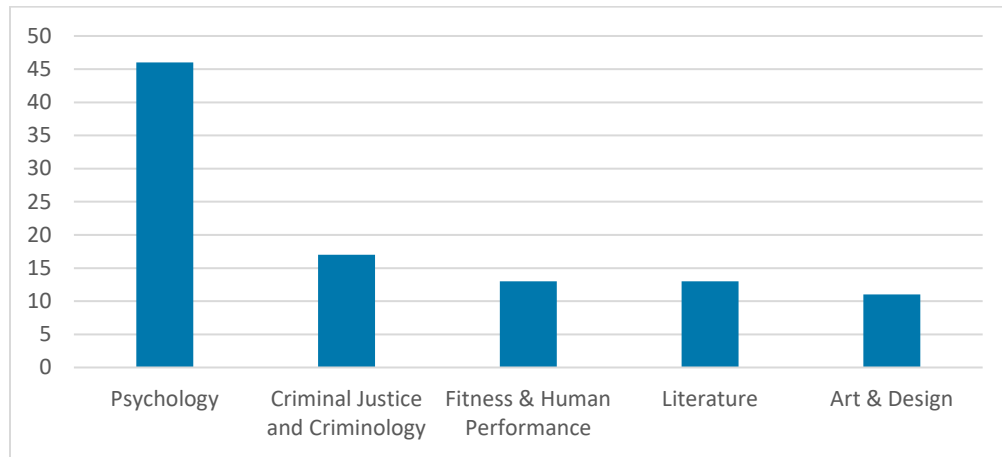

What is your primary degree program in the College of Human Science and Humanities?

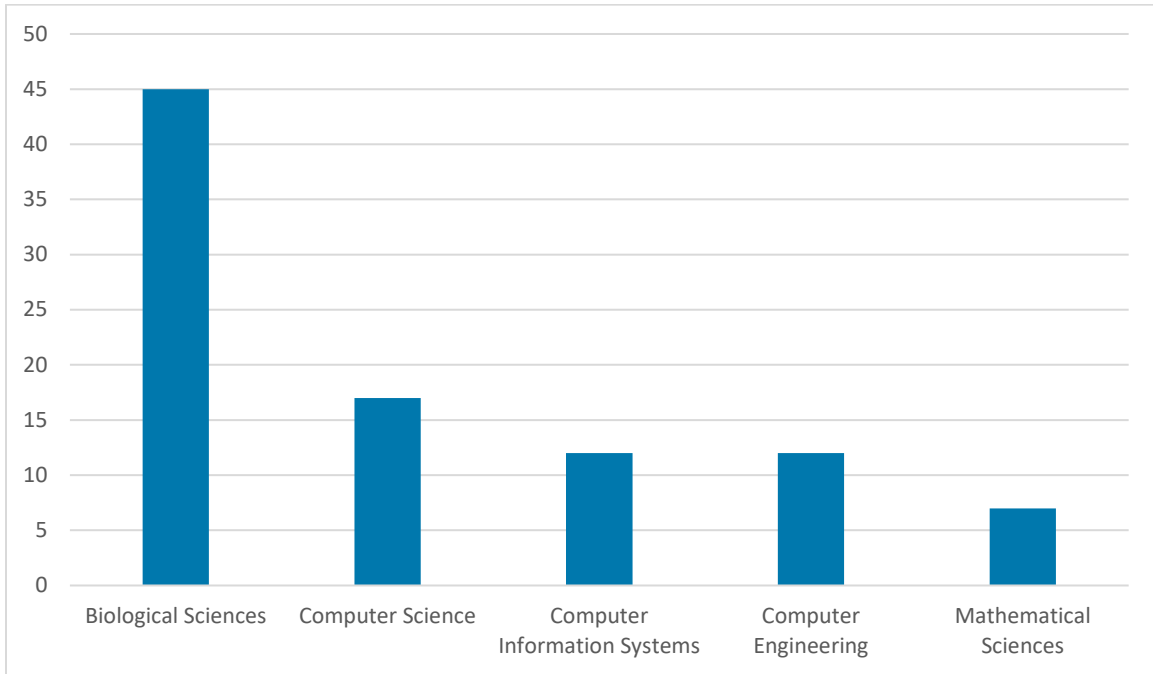

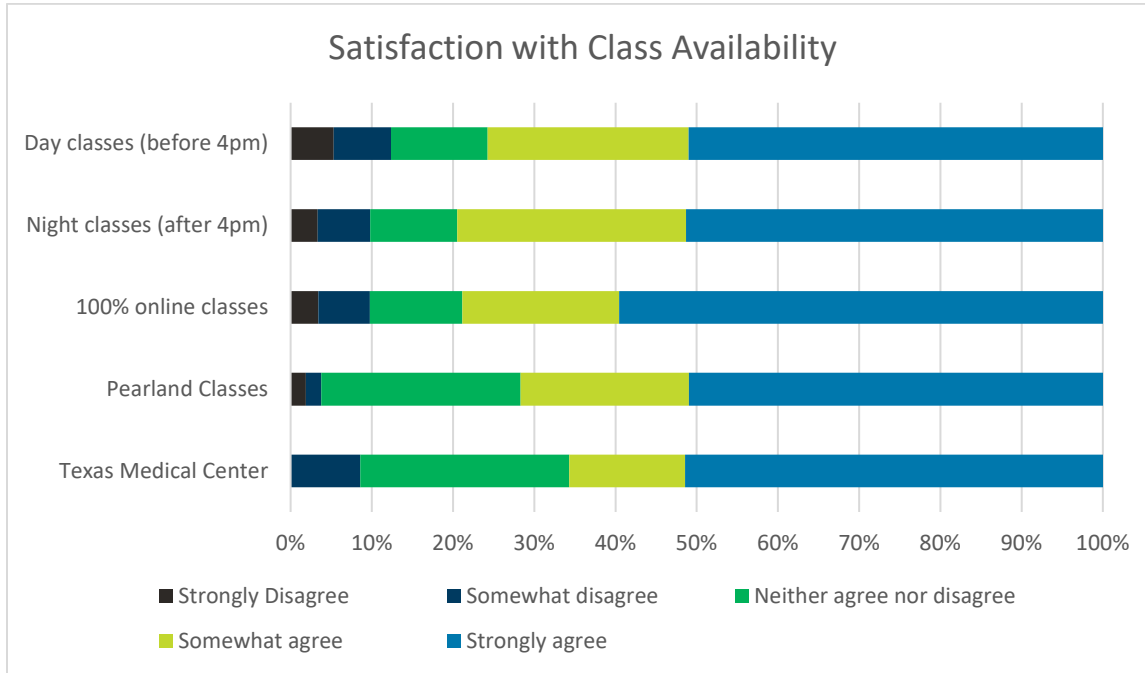
What is your primary degree program in the College of Science and Engineering?

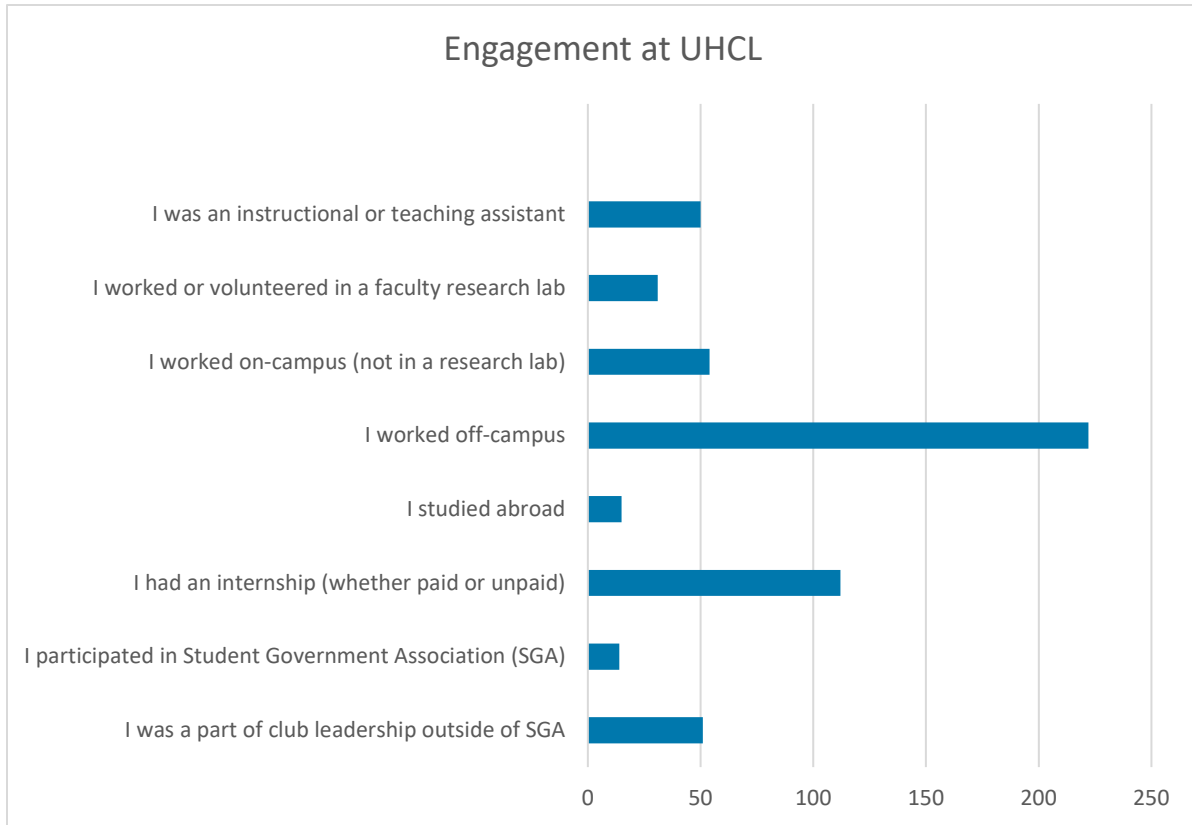

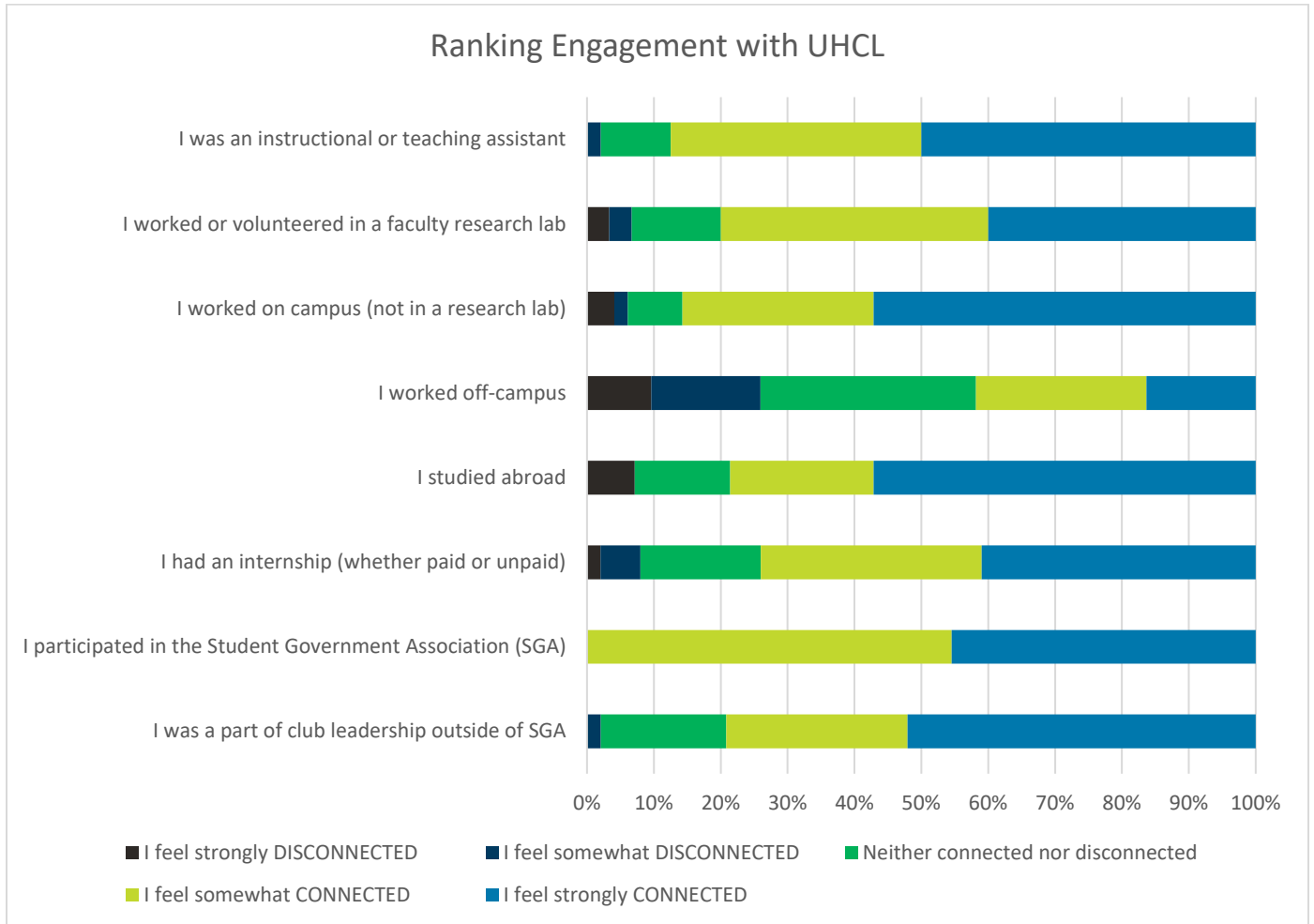

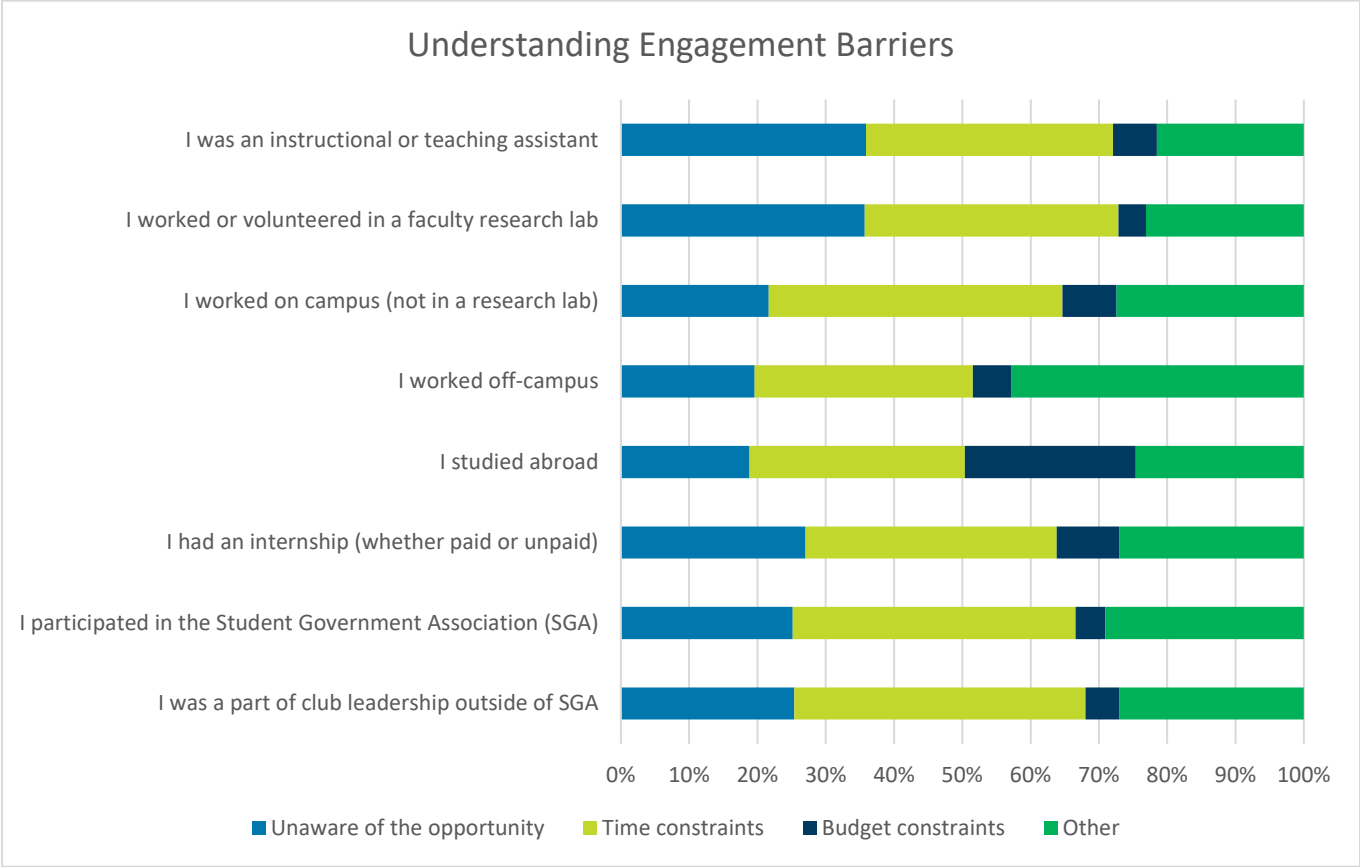

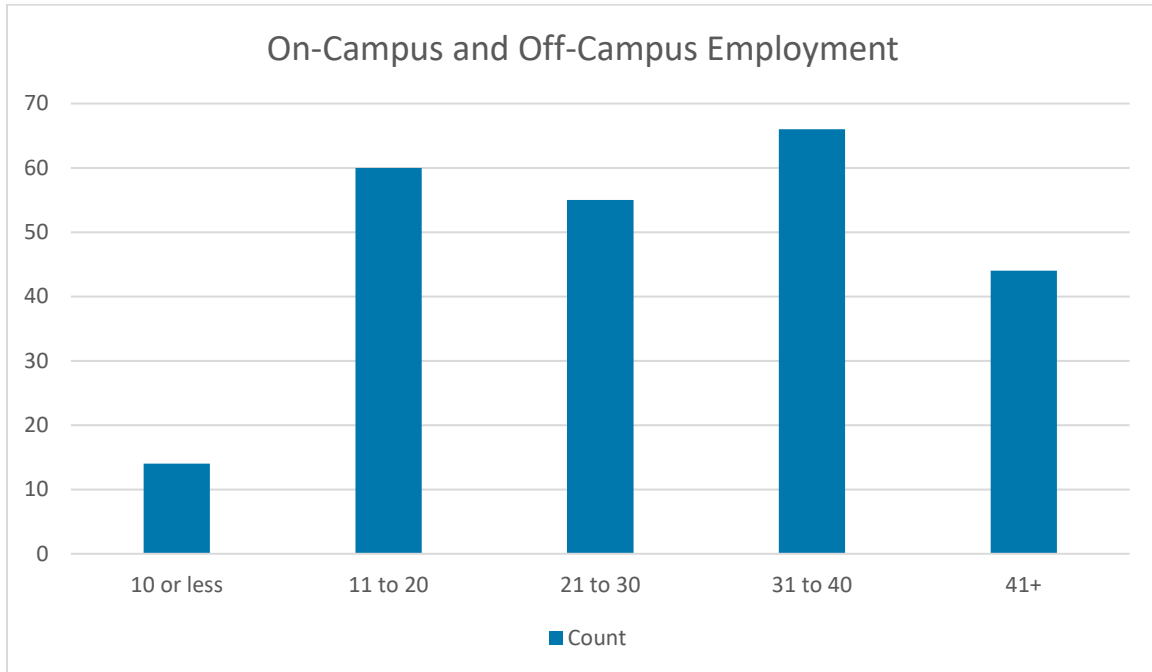

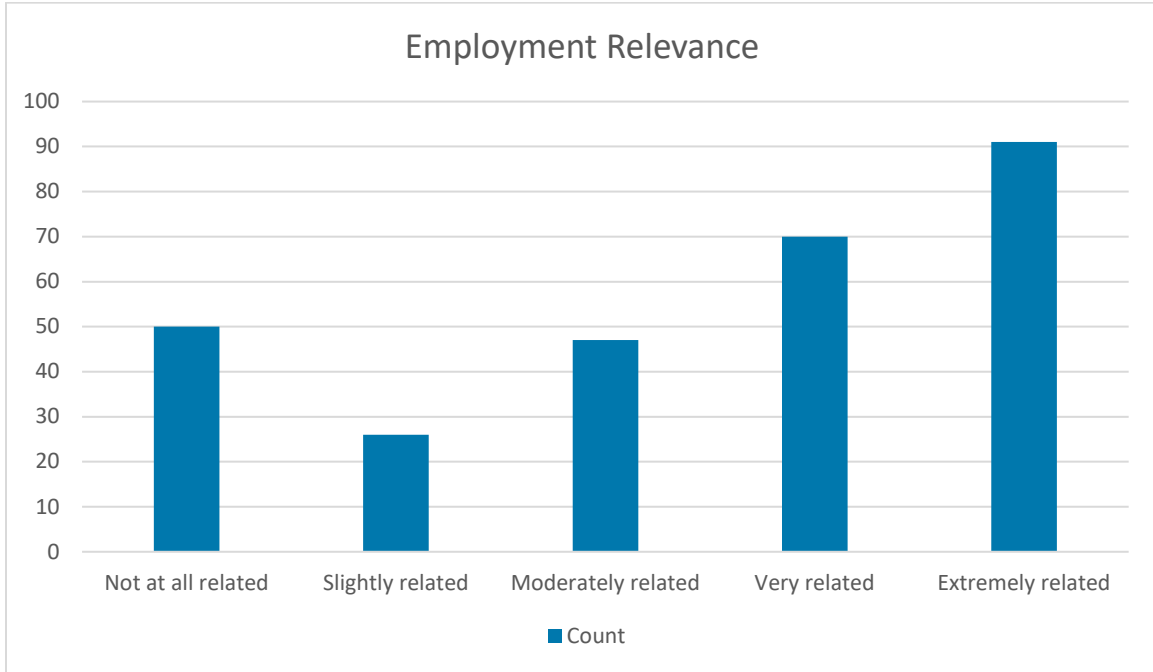

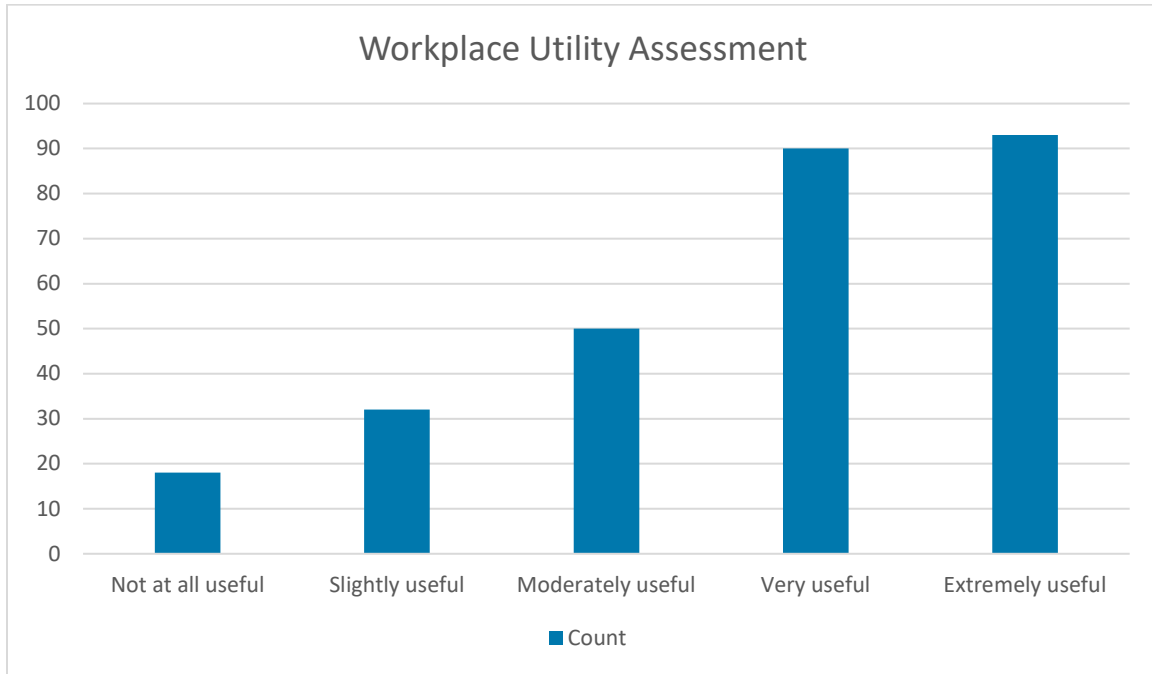

To what extent is your employment related to your major or area of study at UHCL if employed, self-employed, or volunteering?



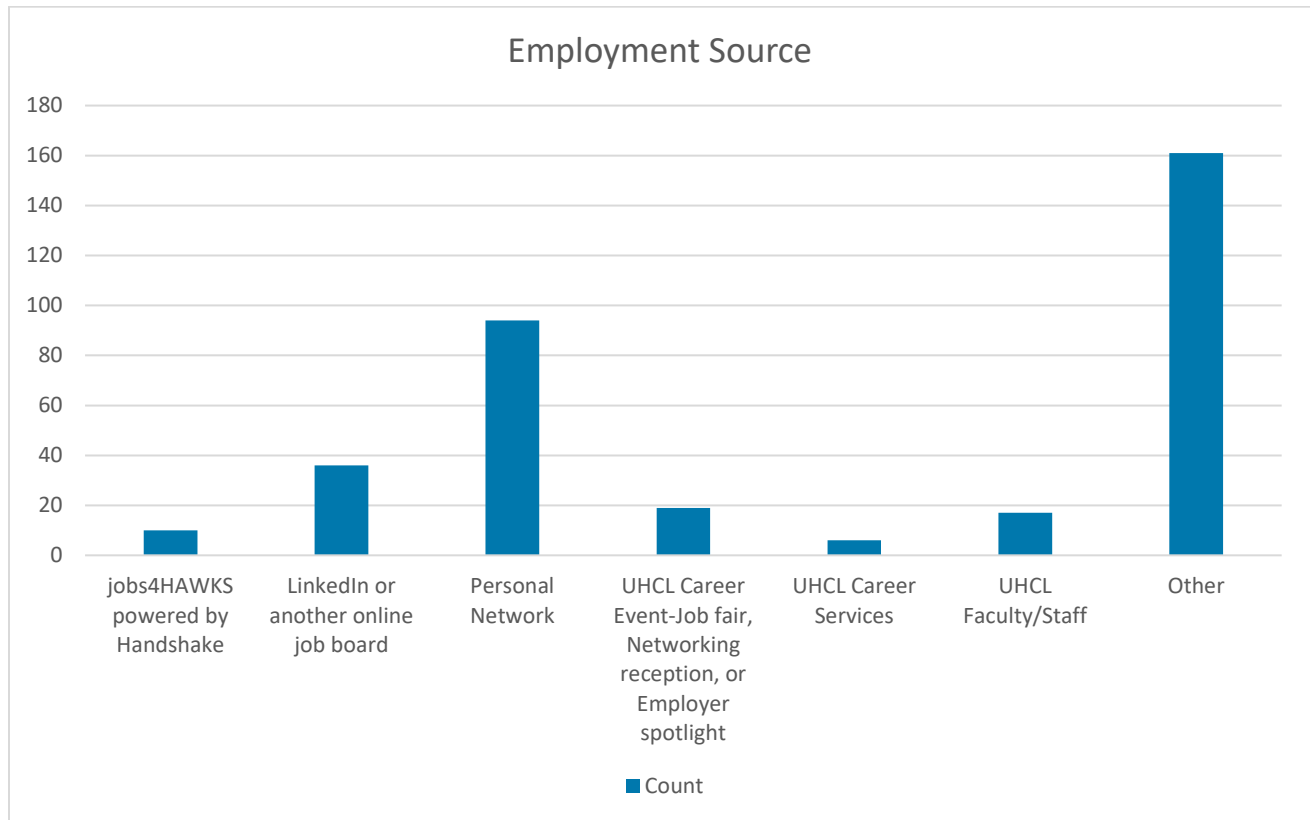

If employed, self-employed, or volunteering, how useful is what you learned at UHCL in your daily work at your place of employment?



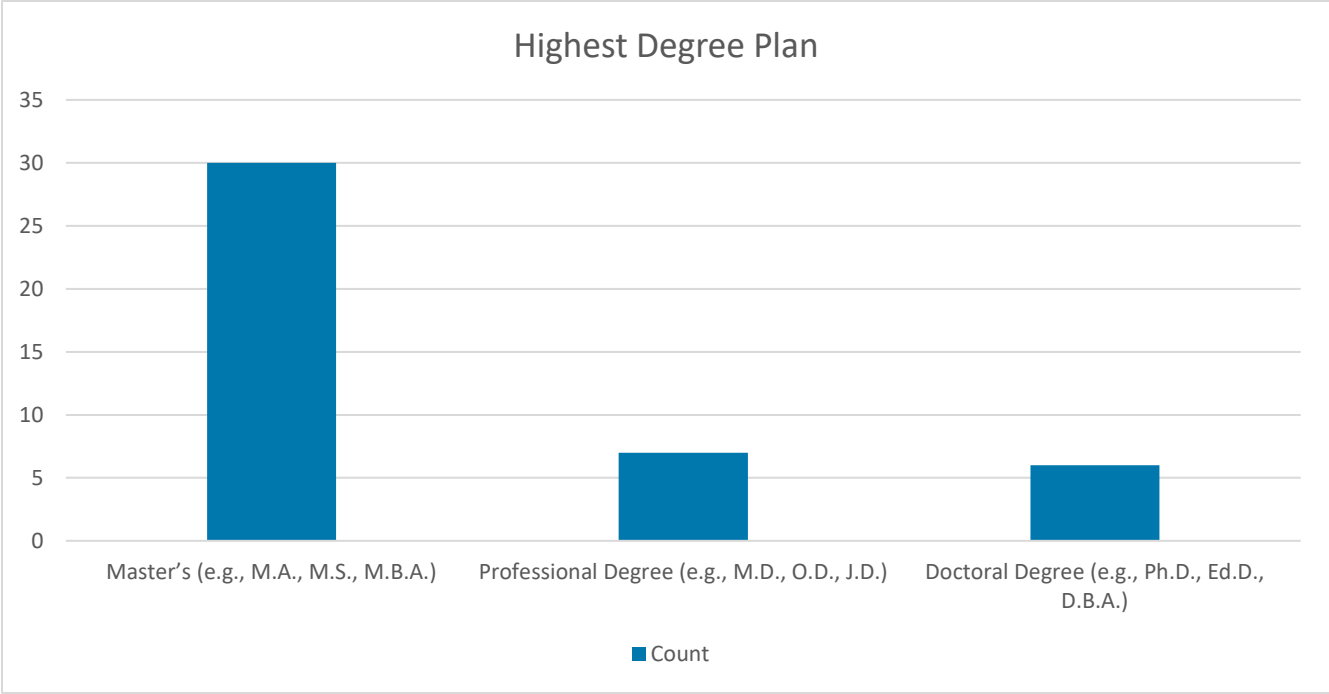

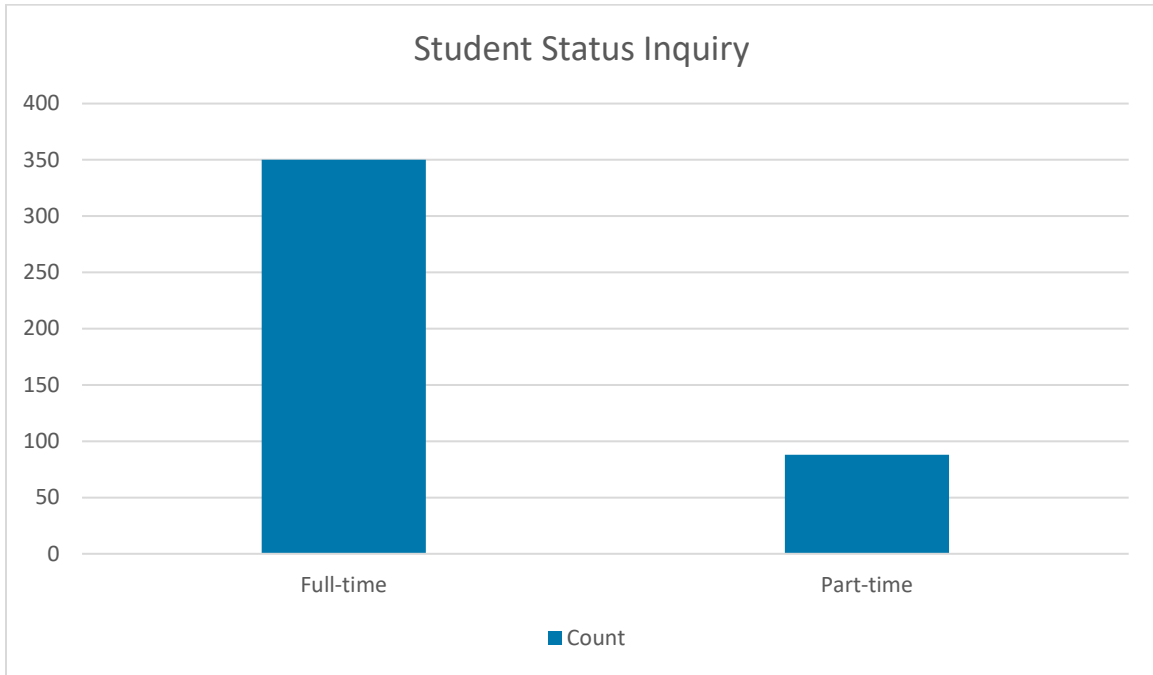

If you're continuing as a full-time or part-time student, what is the highest degree you plan to earn?



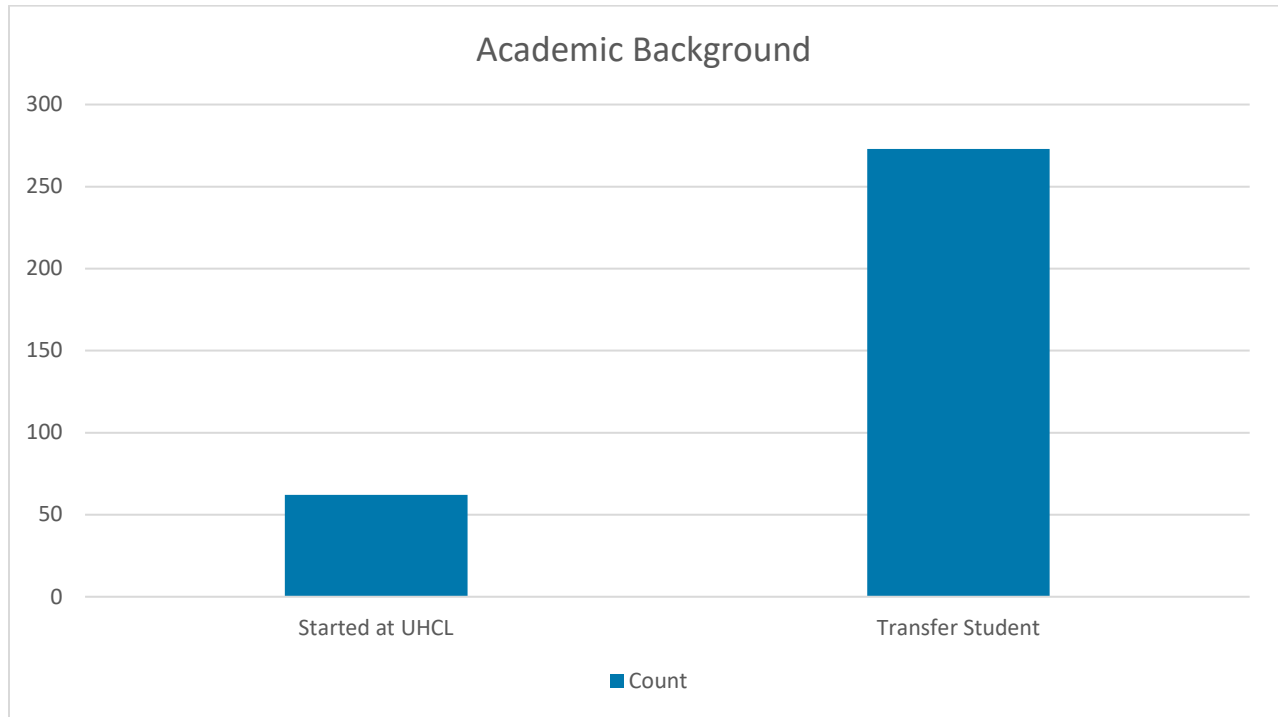

Were you primarily a full-time or part-time student while at UHCL?



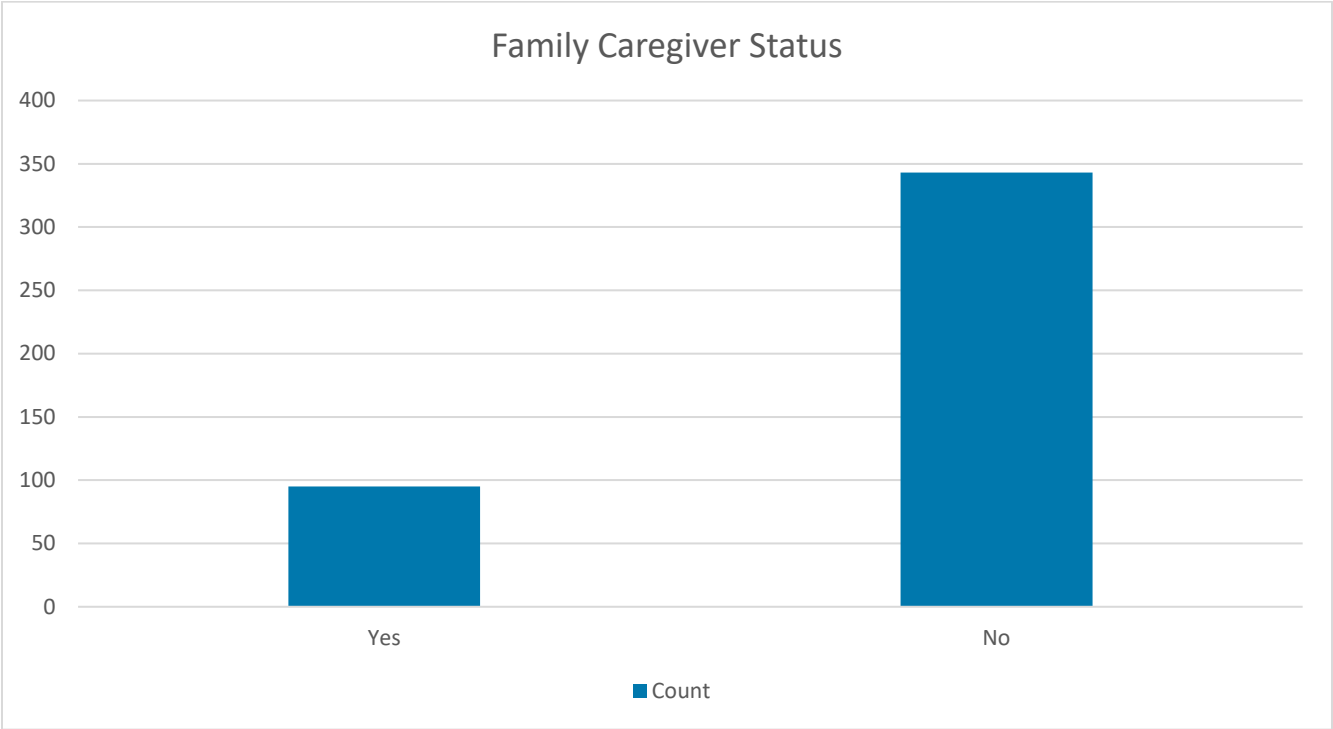

Did you start your undergraduate education at UHCL, or did you transfer from another institution?



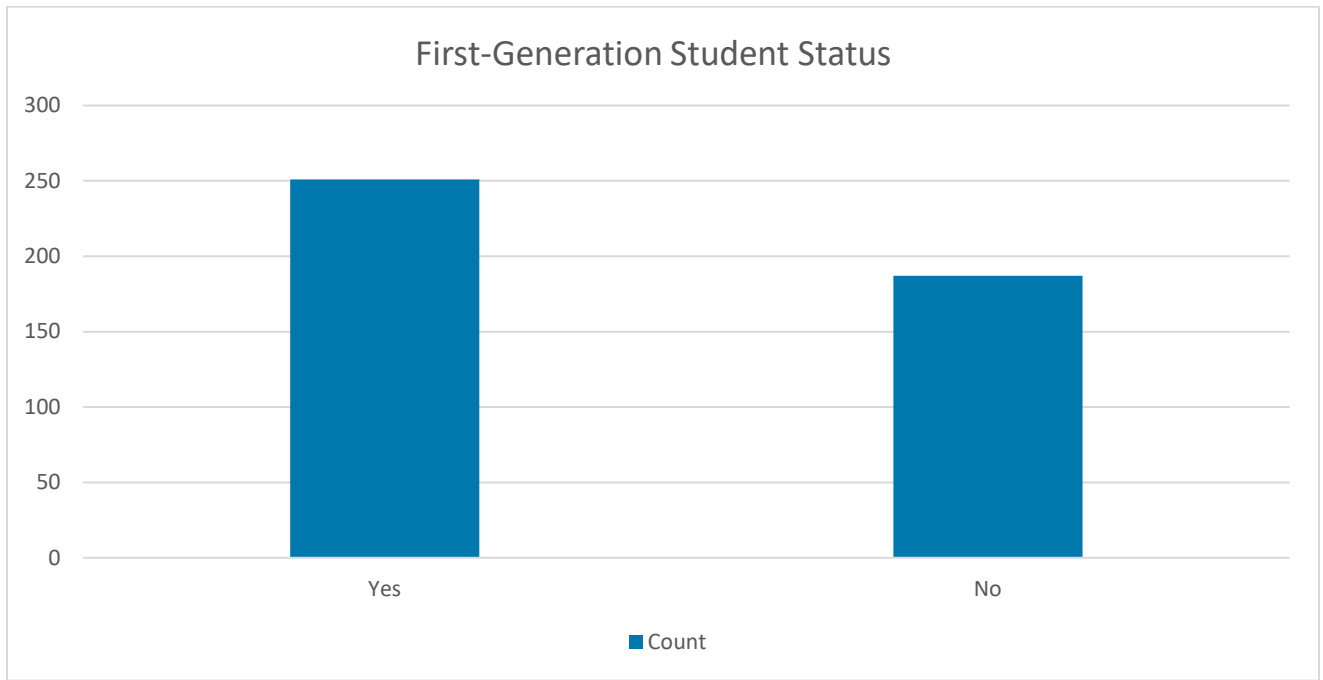
