Recommendations:

- Consider a questionnaire when requesting a permit for the year for faculty/staff.
- Spots in the circle drive of the Bayou Building can be used by visitors who have a handicap placard/plate. This information is not noted on the spots themselves, and is not on the parking website.
- There is no indication under visitor parking on the website <u>at all</u> where visitors in need of a handicap space might locate them on campus and which spots they are allowed to use. The section marked "Disabled parking" only refers to faculty, staff, and students. That information should be made more available to people.
 - When coordinating speakers and other visitors to campus, staff don't know where to tell
 visitors that need Accessible Parking where to park, other than to try the student lot. It
 seems like an easy request for them to update the website from an accessibility
 standpoint to make information clearer and more relevant.
