

1. **Meeting called to order by Chair, Nelson Carter**
2. **Approval of Meeting Notes: Meeting minutes:** February 8, 2024 – unanimously approved.
3. **Old Business**
  1. Information Items
    1. USA Parking Spot Map
      1. The map is ready to be shared out – it was shared to Becky Huss-Keeler chair of FSSC
      2. Thank you to Christine Paul for presenting to FSSC! – No concerns from FSSC afterwards and items has been closed.
    2. Parking Chains/Bollards
      1. Doug Wells will present a plan title, “New Parking Lot Segmentation Strategy and Corresponding Lot Adjustments.” – The plan is to replace the old bollards with more durable ones. Nelson suggested to add some type of legal liability disclaimer signage for any vehicle damage if anyone runs into the bollards by accident (in the past people could make a claim against the university). There will also be a new configuration of parking Lot D to give more spaces (no resizing of spaces just configuration) and signage will be changed to show the correct Lot. Per Mr. Wells, the goal for this to be implemented is Fall 2024. These items are for this committee to recommend then it will go to FSSC and UC as an advisory item.
    3. Accessible Parking
      1. Lot B
        1. Doug Wells will explain a plan for all Accessible Parking in Lot B to accommodate: Bayou, SSCB, and STEM. – We’ll need to find out from the construction firm the spaces needed before making decision on reconfiguration of Accessible Parking in Lot B for the buildings in question.
      2. Visitors (not lot specific)
        1. Parking will explain a plan to improve awareness of accessible parking for visitors. Per Doug Wells – they are looking at the Parking & Transportation website to add the information, the spots will be in the Bayou Circle, some spots already there and there will be a total of 4 that are the closest to the building but need to add the correct markings on the floor as well as standing signage (1 already marked as Van accessible).
    4. Future Parking
      1. If/when the Student Center is constructed in lot B, what is UHCL’s plan to accommodate parking for all employees and students? – Mr. Denney suggested to table this item until next Fall when there is more information regarding the construction.
  2. Action Items
    1. Vote to “recommend or not recommend” the “New Parking Lot Segmentation Strategy and Corresponding Lot Adjustments.” – Unanimously agreed to Motion to Vote to recommend from this committee.
    2. Special marked parking spots in Lot B – Nelson suggested to contact Health Services by Harry or Nelson for explanation of the need for that department to keep the spaces.
    3. Nelson suggestion - If anyone hears from colleagues that parking Lot D is congested, let Harry know and cc Doug & Chris so they can collect the data. Parking can share that data with the Committee before the 1<sup>st</sup> Fall meeting.

4. ***New Business/Announcements***

1. Information Items

1. Direction of traffic flow in “the U.” (Front of Bayou by Statue). Nelson – suggested to add yellow arrows (or some other type of marking) on the lane to show the flow. Doug – suggested to add one- way sign at the exit of parking Lot A (if none currently) or extend the exit island so drivers coming out of the lot cannot turn left.

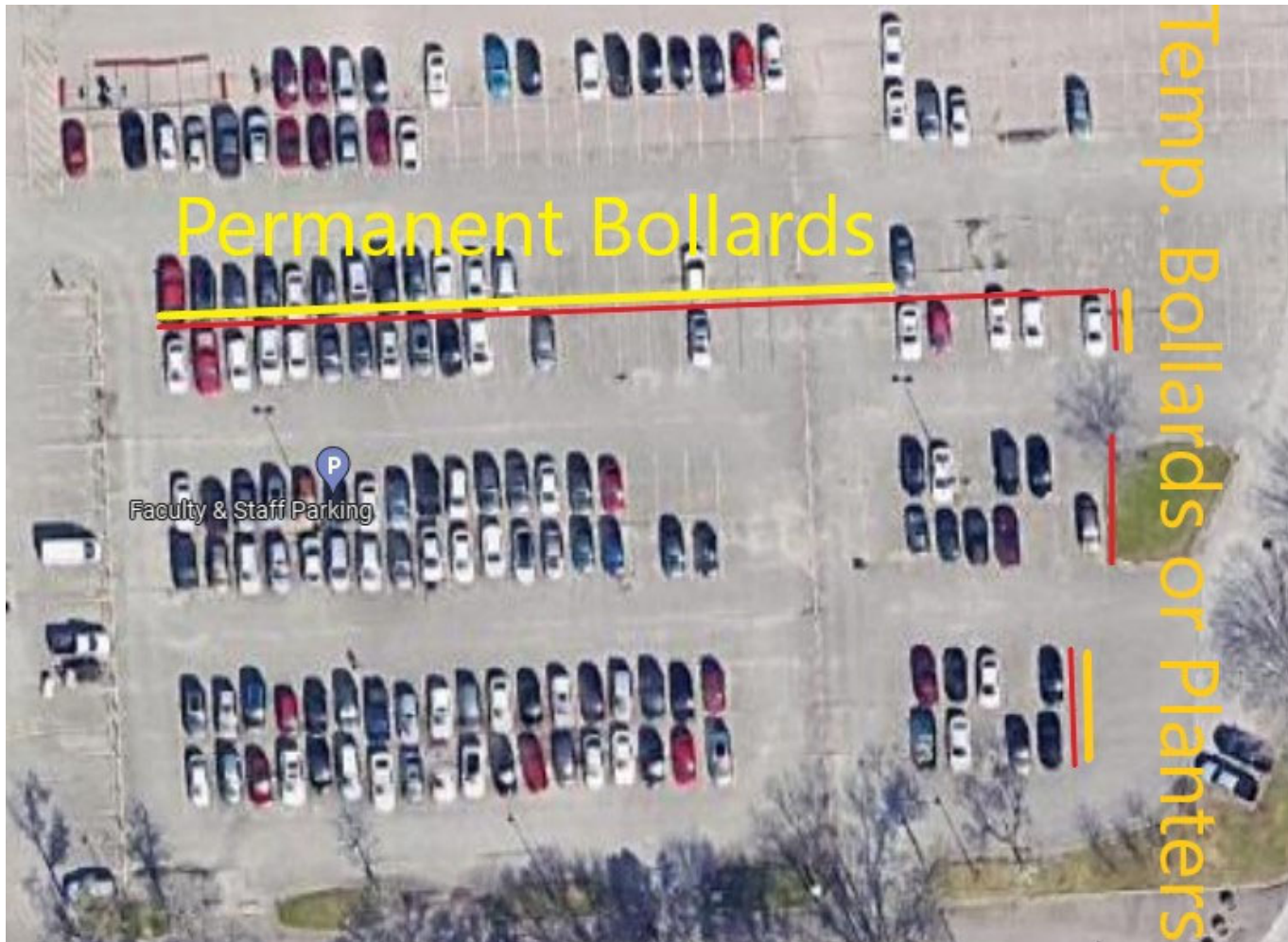


# Bayou East Faculty/Staff Parking

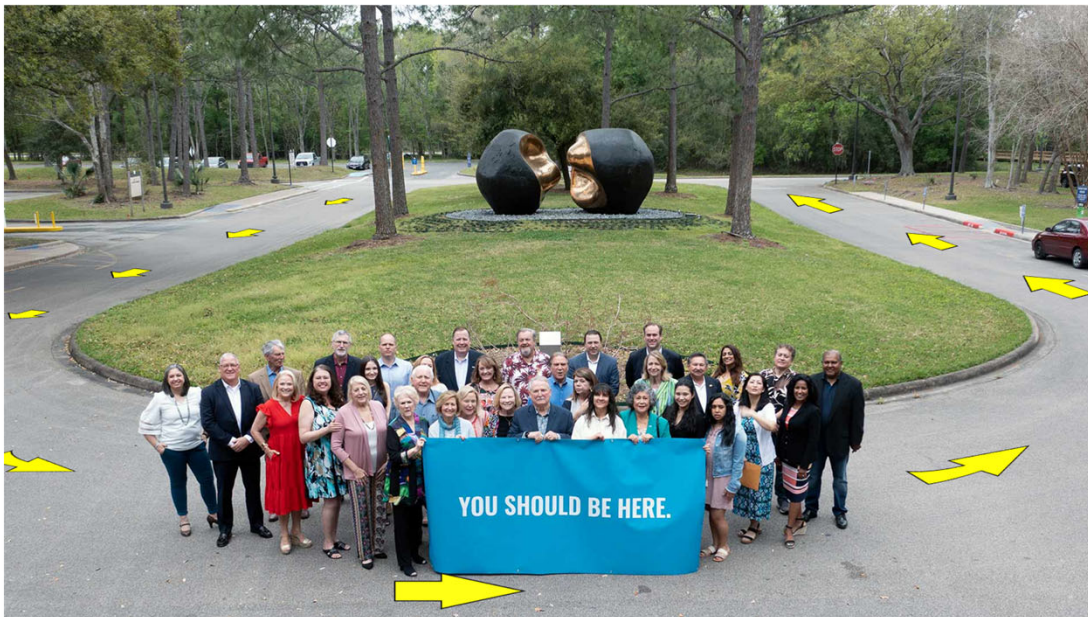
