 - Tier I: Mark Denney personally anticipates no initiatives as these are Institutional wide, and the intent of our Strategic Planning Process is that the Tier II Initiatives are at the Division and Departmental level, and build up to support the Tier I strategic Initiative.
 - Tier II: Anticipate mostly realignment of existing funding, with one-two new resource initiatives coming forward for inclusion in the budget as Budget Initiatives
- Conversation with PBC process for providing feedback
 - Options:
 - Score demonstrates support for or against as well as can be used to illustrate ranking
 - Yes/No demonstrates support but not ranking, does identify items that are not recommended to include in the budget
 - Ranking explicitly ranks, prioritizes etc.
 - Use of those feedback options
 - Recognizing these are still a recommendation the President could still select to support an item that overwhelmingly received a NO vote, or a very low score or ranking.
 - We will continue to provide detail back to PBC the rationale for those items that are supported by the President and included in the budget, and where possible, reconcile the view of the President or leadership that supported initiatives not supported by PBC.

Ms. Deja Sero, Director Office of Planning & Budget:

- o Updates on development of
 - Budget process timeline
 - Development of Funding Request Form, and
 - Development of Initiatives process for February 2021
- Future tuition/fee increases need to be first presented to SGA, their support or nonsupport will then be included in PBC's recommendation to the President.
 - The only change currently coming forward is to increase the current minimum semester meal plan from \$1,000.00 per semester to \$1,400.00 per semester. The two optional plans will remain as they are: \$1,625.00 and \$2,180.00
 - This will be presented to SGA at their next meeting then to PBC.
 - Due to the timing of these meetings, it may require a special session of PBC
