UHCL MAP 05.C.11 – Alcohol Distribution Policy

Matthew Perry presented the new policy on behalf of Dean Rachita.

The committee has been proactive in addressing the need to provide guidance around the sale, use, and consumption of alcohol on campus for both student and non-student events. This policy is an extension of the UH policy and guidelines and has been progressing through the review process.

The policy applies to all university-sponsored activities and functions, both formal and informal, for all colleges, departments, offices, student clubs and organizations, and any events where alcohol is present/served. The comprehensive policy outlines the general guidelines and specific requirements for event approval.

Key points throughout the policy are:

- Who can serve alcohol on campus?
- Who do you use for the alcohol?
- Can it be free of charge?

- Officers at the events are required when alcohol is being served.
- Food at the event is required.

Approval Process:

Events with non-students will be through the President, Vice President. Approval for student events is directly through the Dean of Students Office.
