UHCL will accept all **72 hours** for the transfer courses listed above <u>toward this particular degree's requirements</u>. Students are encouraged to follow the Associate of Arts in Social and Behavioral Sciences at their community college, which will enable you to incorporate the <u>Field of Study (FOS)</u> and other Social Sciences classes toward your "Transfer Path" requirements. However you may transfer and continue to complete your remaining <u>Texas Core</u> requirements through your current college or through UH-Clear Lake main campus while also completing the upper-level coursework.
