SUBJECT: Off-Campus Teaching Compensation

I. PURPOSE

This policy establishes compensation for faculty teaching an off-campus course. The policy does not apply to study abroad courses or on-campus courses with off-campus field trips.

II. DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 Faculty: Tenured, tenure-track, and non-tenure-track full time employees.
- 2.2 Off campus course: A course scheduled for and taught in a location other than the UHCL Clear Lake, UHCL Pearland, or UHCL at Texas Medical Center campuses.

III. POLICY STATEMENT

Faculty teaching an off-campus course will be paid a mileage stipend to cover the cost of traveling from their assigned campus office to the instruction site. The stipend will be calculated according to the following formula:

Stipend = (round-trip distance from assigned campus office to instruction site \times number of class sessions per semester) \times current IRS standard mileage rate
